



The Pedestrian Art Program announces a call to artists
for public outdoor sculpture to be exhibited
June – December 2010

This exhibition will feature five sculptures by local artists residing in the
Greater Wilmington area, including New Hanover,
Brunswick and Pender counties.

Deadline for Entries: April 15, 2010

About the Program

The Pedestrian Art Program is a public sculpture program intended to serve as an economic, cultural, and visual stimulus for New Hanover County region. The non-profit organization, CreativeWilmington, in partnership with the City of Wilmington, and Wilmington Downtown, Inc has selected sites in the Central Business District (CBD) of downtown Wilmington to make art accessible to the general public.

Sculptures are placed at:

- Two on Riverwalk, at the entrances to the scenic walkway along the Cape Fear riverfront
- The Historic Post Office on North Front Street
- The corner of 3rd and Chestnut Street
- Bijou Park located on the 200 block of North Front Street

The outdoor sculptures may represent a wide range of artistic styles, themes, and mediums, and may explore concepts of space, form and imagination.

The Pedestrian Art Program views public art as integral to a community's fabric by recognizing the potential of art to create livable cities, enhance neighborhood identity, strengthen economic development and tourism, educate children and adults, and enrich the spirit and pride of its citizens.

Eligibility

Exhibition is open to residents of in the Greater Wilmington area, including New Hanover, Brunswick and Pender counties. .

Sculptures must be able to be bolted securely to a 4 ft X 4ft concrete base.

Sculptures must be able to withstand the elements, including heavy wind and rain.

Sculptures must not pose a danger to anyone, as they will be in direct contact with the public.

Artists must be available to assist with installation and de-installation.

Awards

There will be a \$1000 award for each sculpture accepted to the exhibition. This award is all-inclusive: artist stipend, travel, and installation.

Application Instructions

Entries must be postmarked by **April 15, 2010**.

Artists may submit up to three (3) **completed** sculptures.

There is no entry fee.

Submissions must include:

- Images of up to three (3) **completed** sculptures. Include at least two different views of each work. Images must be saved as jpeg files on a CD that is both mac and pc compatible. Label your files with your last name and the title.

- Completed application form. Please note any special equipment needs in your proposal.

- Current resume

- A self-addressed stamped envelope if you would like your CD returned.
